## **\*** Remarks of Work Review:

- I. Review criteria:
- (I) Professor: A teacher who has produced unique works on a continuous basis and made a major and substantive contribution to their field.
- (II) Associate Professor: A teacher who has produced works on a continuous basis and made a substantive contribution to their field.
- (III) Assistant Professor: A teacher who has produced works that meet the standards of a doctorate holder.
- (IV) Lecturer: A teacher who has produced works that meet the standards of a Master of Arts.
- II. "Specific achievements between the current application level and the previous level and within 7 years" includes representative works (within 5 years and the previous level). Applicants who have been pregnant or have given birth during the aforementioned period may apply for a two-year extension to the year limits for the representative works and the

- reference achievements.
- III. The grading system for external review is comprised of four grades: A (Excellent), B (Good), C (Satisfactory), and D (Unsatisfactory). Reviewers shall rate the applicant based on the research performance of teachers of the same level in the same field of study.
- IV. External Review Passing Grades: Those who are being reviewed by 3 scholars and experts must receive a B or higher grade from 2 reviewers. Those who are being reviewed by 5 scholars and experts must receive a B or higher grade from 4 reviewers. Those who are being reviewed by 7 scholars and experts must receive a B or higher grade from 6 reviewers.
